- Plans, directs, coordinates, and reviews the work of professional accounting staff; assigns work activities
 and projects; monitors workflow; reviews and evaluates work products, methods, and procedures; create
 reporting efficiencies and related process improvements including strengthening internal controls over
 financial reporting; meets with staff to identify and resolve problems.
- Compiles and analyzes financial information to review, approve and post journal entries for all general ledger accounts, documenting transactions; analyzes financial information detailing assets, liabilities, and fund balance.
- Interprets general accounting principles and financial procedures to management.
- Assigns, supervises, and reviews the work of professional accountants. Develops work standards and conducts staff performance evaluations. Conducts and coordinates staff training and development.
- Reviews forecasts of anticipated expenses and revenues, ensuring projections are based on valid economic trends.
- Research GAAP and GASB literature to ensure compliance with current standards.
